Dear Circuit friends,

Greetings and welcome, from a newbie to the circuit.

If you have noticed a 'Spinks' popping up on the plan, then newsflash! It is not just me the newly retired Deacon but also my daughter Deborah, local preacher for more than 20 years, who has moved with me and she is doing more appointments than me this year!

We have received a warm welcome in this circuit and at Hadleigh Methodist, our local church congregation. For the last 30 years I have been moving around the country as the church has directed and have now come home, well nearly! I lived for my first 35 years in Laindon and Basildon.

It was in St Paul's Methodist Church Basildon that I came to faith at 15 from a non-churched family and from the very beginning I found the church a very strange animal indeed. From early days I have always understood why the church is not always as easy to relate to as church folk think.

I have spent most of my 30 years of ministry trying to help churches invite people into a living relationship with Jesus which is the only thing that kept me going to church when I bumped into the church culture I didn't understand or relate to very well, especially the unspoken rules and expectations that are never explained.

As Deborah and I get around the circuit I am sure we will bump into a few more of those. I sometimes think the church should employ a mystery shopper to help us grasp what we are too familiar to notice. I still believe the church is the most important way of helping people to come to a living and growing relationship with God.

I look forward to sharing with you in going out into our community with the good news of Jesus and, by the power of the Holy Spirit, being part of a church community that works to warmly welcome strangers in our midst.



BOOK REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS





Christmas at The Experience Project






